

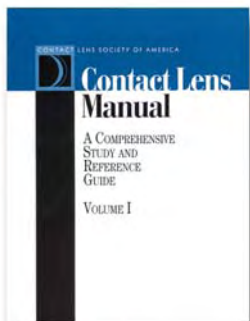

## Membership Classifications

**Affiliate**—A non-voting member who does not meet the experience and/or educational requirements for regular membership or is associated in business with a member of regular or higher status.

**Regular**—Must have two years of contact lens fitting experience and/or two years of advanced education and who practices within the statutory requirements of his state.

**NCLE Certified**—Has passed the Contact Lens Registry Exam and maintains certification with the NCLE. May sit for the Fellow exam without restriction.

**Fellow Status**—A regular or NCLE certified member who has passed a written and oral exam administered by the CLSA Fellow Committee.

**Honored Status**—A classification recognizing significant participation in the CLSA and/or contributions to the industry. An individual must earn service points for participation in educational or other society activities over a period of five years.

**Retired**—Fully retired non-voting member with at least five years previous membership in CLSA. Eligible for normal discounts, listed in roster as retired.

**Student**—A person attending an accredited opticianry or ophthalmic training school.

**Associate**—Non-voting corporate membership open to firms supplying contact lenses and/or related products or services to the ophthalmic industry.

International members: Payment by check of U.S. dollars drawn on a U.S. bank only or by credit card.
